We are open:

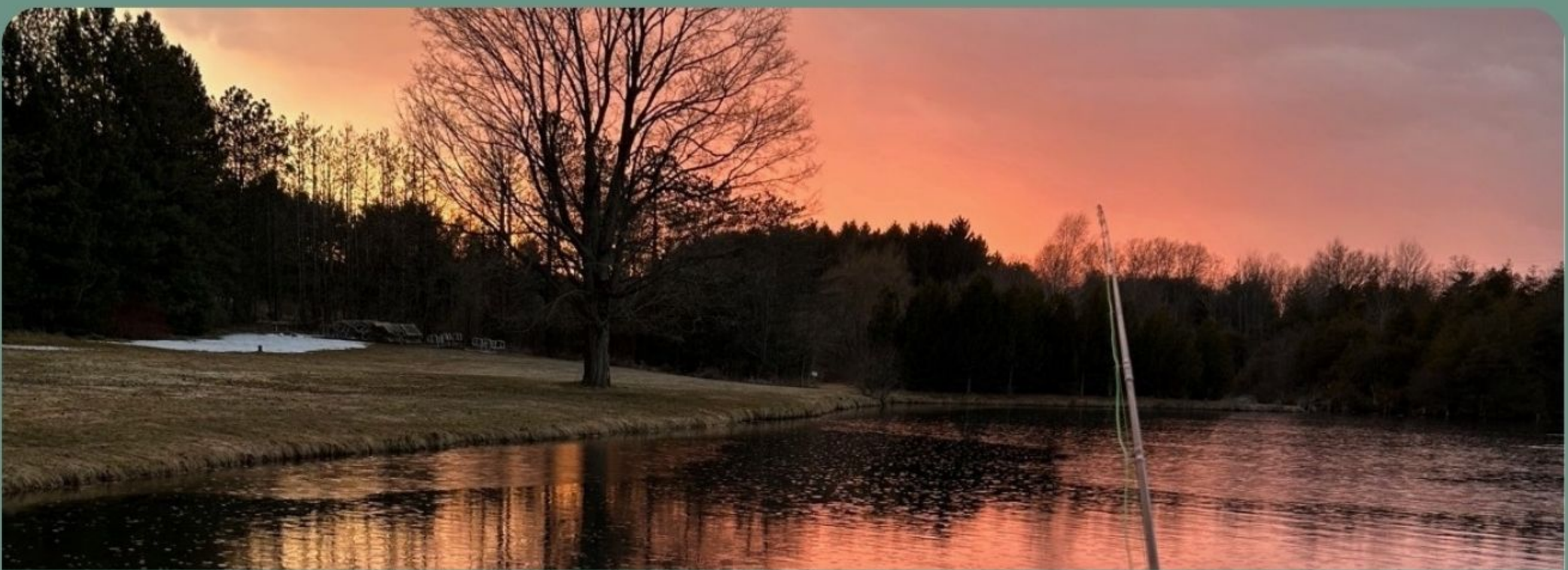
April 11 & 12 from 9am to 5pm

Value Fishing Pack \$99.00

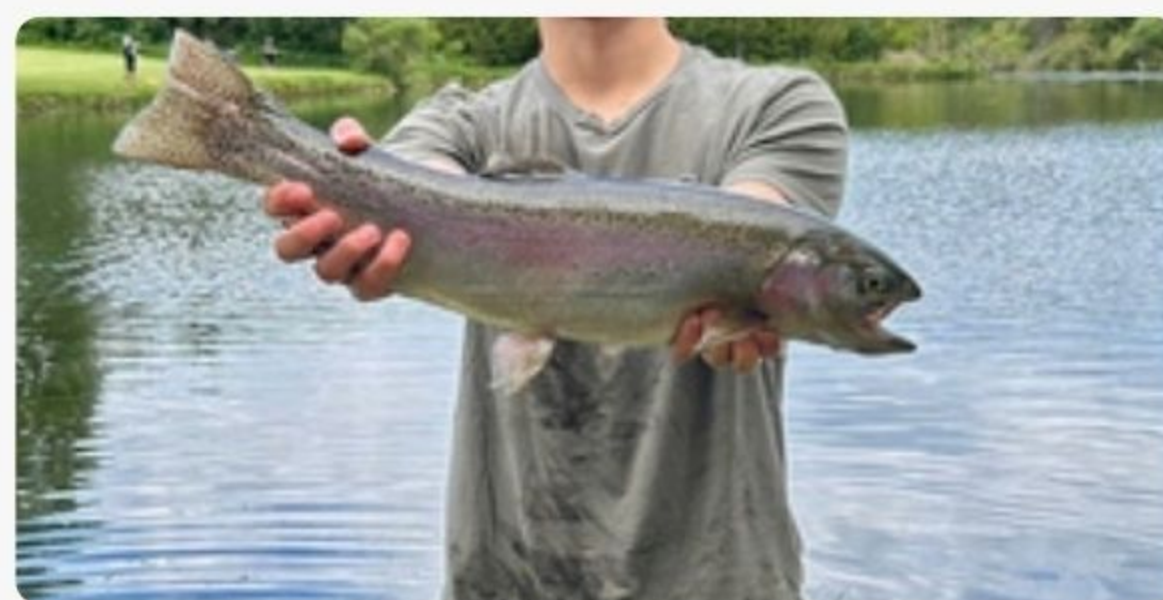
Includes: 4 Admission passes, 4 Fish (cleaned and bagged), a combination of 4 drinks or snacks, worms, 1 cup of fish food to feed the fish or use as bait. This does not include the rod rental.



Spin Reel Fishing

- \$5.00 Admission (includes: nets, bait, fish cleaning, bags and ice) Free Admission to anyone under the age of 10.
- \$6.00 Rod Rental (this is optional, you can bring your own)
- 1 to 5 Fish at \$25.00 per fish regardless of size.
- 6+ Fish at \$22.00 per fish regardless of size.

The average fish weighs 2 to 2.5lbs, approximately \$10 to \$12.50 per lb



Fly Fishing

Per Hour \$25.00

Per Day \$75.00

Barbless hooks for catch and release only. Minimum 6lb test. recommended for 8lb plus.

Any injured fish, we ask that you please keep and pay for your trout at \$25.00 per fish.

01 General

- All guests must check in before fishing.
- Fishing is permitted only in designated areas.
- Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Please follow all instructions provided by staff.
- You do not need a fishing licence.
- There is no limit on how many fish you can catch.
- We are a smoke, vape, and alcohol free facility.

02 Fishing and Equipment

- One rod per person unless approved by staff.
- No, spears, or unauthorized fishing equipment.
- We can provide fishing poles, or you can bring your own.
- Fish must be handled with care at all times.

03 Catch Policy

- No Catch and Release unless you are Fly Fishing
- All retained fish must be recorded and paid for before leaving.
- No returning fish to the pond once kept.

Pond Rules

When fishing at Lyndon Fishing Pond, the regular rules do not apply. We have a few of our own rules to ensure the safety of our fish, employees and customers. Lyndon Fishing Pond assumes no liability for our visitors.

04 Safety

- Life jackets are recommended for young children.
- No running on pond edges.
- Be mindful of hooks and casting near others.
- Report any unsafe conditions to staff immediately.

05 Respect the Property

- Please dispose of waste in designated bins.
- Do not disturb wildlife or pond infrastructure.
- No glass containers near the pond.
- No pets are allowed.
